

MAKING A POND DIPPER

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- TIGHTS
- WIRE COAT HANGER
- HEAVY DUTY TAPE
- SCISSORS
- BAMBOO



INSTRUCTIONS

- YOU'LL NEED TO START BY BENDING YOUR WIRE COAT HANGER INTO A SQUARE SHAPE WITH THE HOOK ON ONE CORNER.
- ATTACH THE HOOK END TO THE PIECE OF BAMBOO USING THE HEAVY DUTY TAPE.
- USE THE TIGHTS TO FORM A NET IN BETWEEN THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE WIRE COAT HANGER. USE THE HEAVY DUTY TAPE TO FIX IT OR TIE IT ON.
- MAKE SURE THE INSIDE OF THE NET IS SECURE AND THAT NOTHING CAN GET THROUGH, THIS IS WHERE YOU'LL BE CATCHING YOUR POND LIFE.

HOW IT WORKS

- STAND AT THE EDGE OF THE WATER, MAKING SURE NOT TO FALL IN. IF YOU'RE YOUNG, TAKE AN ADULT ALONG.
- PUT THE NET IN THE WATER AND REST IT FACE UP ON THE BOTTOM OF THE POND.
- WITH A BUCKET ON HAND WITH A LITTLE WATER IN IT, MOVE THE NET UP AND DOWN AND PUT THE CONTENTS IN THE BUCKET.
- MAKE SURE YOU ALWAYS HANDLE ANY POND LIFE WITH CARE, WEARING GLOVES WHERE NEEDED.
- ALWAYS RETURN THE POND LIFE TO THE POND AFTER YOU'VE STUDIED THEM.
- BE CAREFUL TO LEAVE NO TRACE AROUND PONDS.
