

MAKING A POOTER



WICKED WILDLIFE WORKSHOP

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- SMALL CLEAN JAR
- 2 X STRAWS OR TUBES
- MODELLING CLAY
- TIGHTS
- ELASTIC BANDS



INSTRUCTIONS

- TAKE YOUR SMALL CLEAN JAR AND MAKE TWO HOLES IN THE LID. ALSO TAKE OFF ANY LABELS THAT MAY BE OBSCURING YOUR VIEW.
- INSERT THE BENDY STRAWS OR TUBES THROUGH THE HOLES AND USE MODELLING CLAY TO FILL THE GAPS.
- USE A SMALL SQUARE OF TIGHTS MATERIAL AND ELASTIC BAND TO PUT OVER ONE OF THE STRAWS, UNDER THE LID. MAKE SURE YOU KNOW WHICH THIS STRAW IS, TRY MAKING IT SHORTER.
- PUT THE LID BACK ON THE JAR AND USE THE LONGER STRAW TO SUCK UP SOME BUGS BY SUCKING THROUGH THE SHORTER ONE.

HOW IT WORKS

- MAKE SURE YOU KNOW WHICH STRAW HAS THE FABRIC ON IT. BY MAKING THIS ONE SHORTER, YOU CAN EASILY IDENTIFY THEM.
- USE THE LONGER STRAW TO SUCK UP THE INSECTS. PLACE THE END OF THE LONGER STRAW NEAR AN INSECT AND SUCK ON THE SHORTER STRAW, THE INSECT SHOULD END UP IN THE JAR.
- THE FABRIC WILL STOP YOU FROM SUCKING UP THE BUG.
- MAKE SURE YOU ONLY SUCK UP BUGS THAT FIT THROUGH THE STRAWS
- ALWAYS RETURN THE BUGS TO WHERE YOU FOUND THEM
- BE CAREFUL WHAT BUGS YOU USE WITH YOUR POOTER, NOT ALL BUGS ARE FRIENDLY!
