

# MAKING PAPER POTS



# WICKED WILDLIFE WORKSHOP

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- PAPER
- COLOURING PENCILS
- PAPER POTTERS
- SCISSORS
- BAMBOO



## INSTRUCTIONS

- YOU'LL START BY COLOURING IN YOUR PAPER PLANT POT. MAKE IT AS EXCITING AND NATURE LIKE AS YOU LIKE.
- CHOOSE THE MOULD THAT'S SUITABLE FOR YOUR SEED SOWING AND PLANTS.
- CUT STRIPS OF YOUR NATURE PAPER WIDE ENOUGH TO FOLD ACROSS THE BASE OF THE MOULD. DO THIS 4-6 TIMES PER POT.
- WRAP TIGHTLY UNDER THE BASE TO CREATE FIRM POTS AND USE THE BASE TO SEAL THE POTS IN PLACE.

## POTTING YOUR PLANTS

- USE THE PAPER POTS WITH NEW SEEDS OR YOUNG PLANTS. ADD SEEDS AND SOIL TO THEM.
- REST THE PLANT POTS IN TRAYS OF DAMP COMPOST. THIS ALLOWS THE PAPER TO REMAIN DAMP AT ALL TIMES FOR ROOTS TO GROW THROUGH.
- ONCE THE PLANTS HAVE ROOTS IT'S TIME TO PLANT THEM IN A REAL POT!
- PLANTS THAT YOU'LL GROW IN YOUR PAPER POTS WILL ATTRACT INSECTS. THOSE INSECTS WILL ATTRACT MORE WILDLIFE.
- PLANTS ARE A BIG PART OF THE FOOD CYCLE AND WE WOULDN'T BE HERE WITHOUT THEM.
